SPINCERVINO (*Rhamnus catharticus*)

This Rhamnaceae grows as large shrub or small evergreen tree in Europe until at 800-1000 m above sea level.

It prefers limestone soils tend to dry, in hot dry climate and full sun exposure.

Height: 8m.

Schema: rounded shrub
Height: up to 5 meters

BARK

Appearance: squamous
Color: brown, gray



LEAF

Shape: Oval
Margin: Serrated
Rib: strum
Arrangement: opposite or alternate



FLOWERS

They are green and yellow trees bloom in May on a separate sexes.

FRUITS

They are arranged in clusters round black drupes.
